

VIVIAN RODRIGUEZ BIOGRAPHY

Vivian Rodriguez retired from the New York City Police Department after completing 21 years of service achieving the highest recognition within the Detective Bureau to First Grade Detective.

During her law enforcement career, she served in many specialized units including the Organized Crime Control Bureau, and the Dignitary and Executive Protection Unit where she safeguarded visiting heads of state including the assignment to protect the NYC Mayor and his family.

Vivian was assigned to the Intelligence Division Liaison Unit during the 9/11 terrorist attack and was involved in various covert anti-terrorism operations to secure New York City and the homeland from future terrorist incidents.

Vivian worked for several years as a consultant and trainer with the Department of Homeland Security delivering a national Anti-Terrorism Intelligence Awareness Training Program to state and local law enforcement agencies.
